Whether you're looking to host an upscale affair, searching for the perfect themed venue or seeking something off the beaten path, Ohio offers a variety of places to say, "I do."

ach bride has a unique vision for her special day. Some prefer a more intimate venue with just enough space for family and close friends, while others picture a party fit for a queen. And while traveling to a beachside retreat or foreign country sounds fun, it can also be expensive. But a destination wedding doesn't have to break the bank: These Ohio locations offer everything from quaint countryside affairs to tropical adventures.

### DICTUDE DEDEECT

At the NorthPointe Hotel and Conference Center in Lewis Center, a professional wedding planner and coordinator will walk you through your big day and the director of catering will personally attend to your entire menu. Although out-of-country weddings are all the rage, it is possible to have an international theme right here in Ohio. Enjoy a Scottish retreat at *Glenlaurel* Inn in Rockbridge, where the stone

The grounds are perfect for small weddings (about 30 guests) and some packages offer themes relating to Scottish heritage, such as an afternoon

"Some guests want a formal Scotland wedding," says Becky Russell, marketing and guest services consultant. "We can have the bagpiper play and we'll cater the wedding to [the couple]."

Guests can stay in rooms, suites, cottages or crofts (small cottages) with a variety of amenities, from indoor whirlpools and outdoor hot tubs to fireplaces and double hammocks.
